

CHÂTEAU MOULINAT

AOP BORDEAUX

Château Moulinat, is a family story, but most of all, a story of women. The winemaker's great grand-mother, her daughter, and then her granddaughter passed along the love of the vine. A very feminine filiation that lasts since the XIXth century, as demonstrated by a stone of the house dated from 1840. The name comes from the nickname of the miller which recalled his functions : "moulinat".

LOCATION: Bordeaux

APPELLATION: AOP Bordeaux

AGE OF VINES: 20 years

FARMING: Manual disbudding, mowing in between the rows, use of less chemicals according to the vines growth and weather.

SOIL: Limestone-clay

VARIETY: 58% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Cabernet Franc

ALC. 13%

TASTING NOTES: Deep purple color, notes of ripe fruit and spices. Powerful and fleshy with silky tannins. Enjoy with grilled or roasted red meat and poultry.
